TENDER NOTICE

Sealed Tenders are invited from experienced and eligible Service Providers for work contract of Semi- skilled Labours (4 Nos.) at the Mumbai Research Centre of Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute, Mumbai- 400 061 as per the schedule of work enclosed (Annexure – I) for the period from April 2017 to March 2018.

Service provider should submit details of the organizations to which they have extended similar services in the recent past as well as present. Service provider should be registered under the provision of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition Act, 1970) and shall be responsible for fulfilling all obligations under various labour laws as applicable and amended from time to time.

The tender fee for Rs 250/- and earnest money of 2.5% of the total contract value must be deposited in the form of DD in favour of ICAR UNIT CMFRI payable at Kochi. The tender will not be considered if tender fee and earnest money is not deposited.

The Service provider should specify the number of personnel they would be providing to this Office and the rate of wages that would be paid to them. The Minimum wages fixed by Central Govt. of India (Ministry of Labour & Employment) should be paid to the personnel deployed; the rate may be quoted accordingly and as per provisions of ministry of State Govt. Rates wherever are higher and admissible can be accepted.

The terms & conditions of the work are given in Annexure – II. Those who are interested may submit their tender in the prescribed format attached herewith (annexure – III, IV, V & VI). The tender should be in a sealed envelope/cover and superscribed as “Tender for work contract of Semi- skilled Labours”. The last date of receipt of tenders 2.00 PM on 25.03.2017 and will be opened on the same day at 2.15P.M. ***No tender shall be entertained after this deadline under any circumstances whatsoever.***

The Scientist-in-Charge of Mumbai Research Centre of Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute reserves the right to amend or withdraw any of the terms and conditions contained in the Tender Document or to reject any or all tenders without giving any notice or assigning any reason.

Schedule of Work

1. Daily cleaning and mopping of entire office building of Mumbai Research Centre of CMFRI office cum lab in 2nd floor of CIFE old campus (about 4000 sq. ft.) The area includes office rooms, laboratories, staircases, corridors and sunshade portion, washbasins etc; and also removing of waste from all the rooms / Laboratories. Complete the cleaning works in all respect under the supervision of the designated officer assigned by the SIC of Mumbai Research Centre of CMFRI.
2. Removing the cob webs regularly in all the rooms as well as the corridor.
3. Cleaning of the Hatchery.
4. Cleaning of toilet ducts (2 Nos.).
5. Daily cleaning of toilets (2 Nos.) in the morning and afternoon including floor wash, Cleaning the wash basin and urinals etc.
6. Preparation and collection of Tea, Snacks, lunch etc from the CIFE Departmental canteen for supply to staff at their working place for half an hour (10.00 - 10.30 hrs) in the forenoon, meals at noon (1300 – 13.30 hrs) and half an hour (1500 - 1530 hrs) in the afternoon.
7. Handling of fresh and Formalin treated Biological samples in fresh and preserved state; proper handling and disposal of fish, crustacean and molluscan samples which have to be wrapped in disposable bags.
8. Disposal of Waste (canteen waste, used specimen and office waste) available at campus to a suitable municipal disposal point without any public nuisance or objection to local bodies.
9. Cleaning & dusting of all the windows, window panes, doors as well as all the furniture in the office once in a month.
10. Arrangement, cleaning and upkeep of Museum specimen, Field/Laboratory/Operational and Administrative works etc.
11. Any other works specially entrusted as and when needed.

Terms and Conditions

1. The Service Provider should abide by the statutory provisions enacted in the labour laws for minimum wages and should fulfill all the statutory obligations under the ESI, Provident Fund rules, bonus etc. in respect of the persons deployed for the works.
2. The Service Provider/agency will be responsible for payment of the revised wages, DA, Bonus, ESI, EPF contribution etc from time to time.
3. The Service Provider must remit the EPF, ESI contribution and Service Tax received from the Institute in the Government Departments concerned through separate challan.
4. Service provider must pay the minimum wages to the persons deployed in this Institute through cheque/draft in their individual bank accounts.
5. The Service Provider must submit the details of distribution of wages of deployed persons to the Institute and copy of ECR Challan form of EPF along with the monthly bill for effecting reimbursement. Further the service provider should submit the copy of the quarterly/ half yearly return of the service tax for verification.
6. The Service Provider shall be responsible for the maintenance of all records / registers as required; the same may be produced before Competent Authority of CMFRI on demand.
7. Number of personnel to be deployed may be specified clearly in the quotation submitted by the Service provider /Agency.
8. The Institute shall not be responsible for any injury caused to any worker during the course of their work. Their treatment / compensation shall not be undertaken by the Institute.
9. It will be the responsibility of the service providing agency to meet transportation, food, medical and any other requirements in respect of the persons deployed by it (Agency) in this Institute and this Institute will have no liability in this regard.
10. The persons posted to work should attend the work between 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM with half an hour lunch break in the afternoon on all working days. In emergent situation, they should also work on holidays. In case, person deployed is absent on a particular day or comes late/leaves early on three occasions, one-day wage shall be deducted.
11. The persons entrusted with the work should carry out the work without causing any damage to the Institute property and disturbance to the staff members. In case of any damage caused, the same will be made good from the payment due to the contractor.
12. The list of personnel deployed for the cleaning work under the contract indicating their name and permanent address should be made available to the undersigned before undertaking the work.
13. The Service providing Agency shall be solely responsible for the redressal of grievances/resolution of disputes relating to persons deployed. This Institute shall, in no way be responsible or settlement of such issues whatsoever.
14. The persons deployed for the work should be issued with proper uniform and I.D. card by the Service Provider for easy identification.
15. ***This office shall provide necessary cleaning materials required for the work.***
16. Changing of workers should be intimated to this Office.
17. The engaged personnel should not develop social relationship with CMFRI staff.

18. The tendering Company/Firm/Agency shall replace immediately any of its personnel who are found unacceptable to this Institute because of security risks, incompetence, conflict of interest, improper conduct etc.
19. The persons employed by the service providing agency shall not claim / shall be entitled to pay, perks and other facilities admissible to regular/confirmed employees of this Department during the currency or after expiry of the contract.
20. In case of termination of this contract on its expiry or otherwise, the persons deployed by the service providing agency shall not be entitled to and will not have claim or any absorption / any relaxation for absorption in the regular/otherwise capacity in the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute.
21. The Service Provider shall immediately provide a substitute in the event of any person absenting from duty on any day or leaving the job due to personal reasons.
22. Successful Tenderer will have to enter a detailed contract agreement with ICAR on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only)
23. 10% of the total amount quoted for twelve months to be deposited at this office as performance security deposit within seven days of intimation of the award of the work. The amount shall be refundable without any interest after successful completion of the contract period.
24. The tendering agency shall also be liable for depositing any taxes, levies, cess etc. on account of service rendered by it to the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute to the statutory authorities concerned from time to time.
25. The Service Provider / agency shall maintain all statutory registers as per rules. The service provider / agency shall produce the same on demand to the concerned authority of this Institute or the authority responsible under law.
26. Tax at Source (TDS) shall be deducted as per the provisions of the Income Tax Department, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect will be provided to the agency.
27. In case, the Service Provider / Agency fails to comply with any statutory/taxation liability under appropriate law, and as a result thereof the Institute is put to any loss/obligation, monetary or otherwise, the Institute will be entitled to get itself reimbursed out of the outstanding bills or the Performance Security Deposit of the agency, to the extent of the loss or obligation in monetary terms.
28. In case of breach of any terms and conditions attached to this contract the performance Security Deposit of the contract will be liable to be forfeited by the Department besides annulment of the contract.
29. The Service Provider / agency shall ensure that the goods, materials and equipments etc. supplied to the personnel for carrying out duties assigned to them are not damaged. If this Institute suffers any loss or damage, then the agency shall be liable to reimburse the loss to this Institute in full.
30. The Annexures of the tender form should be returned intact and pages should not be detached. In the event of the space provided on the schedule form being insufficient for the required purpose, additional pages may be added. Each additional page must be numbered consecutively and signed in full by the tenderer. In such cases reference to the additional pages must be made in the tender form. If any modification of the Annexure is considered necessary it should be communicated by means of a separate letter along with the tenders. Overwriting/erasing in rates to be quoted by the tenderer will not be allowed otherwise the tenders may be rejected.
31. The tenders are liable to be ignored if complete information as required is not given therein or if the particular asked for in the Annexures to the tenders is not fully filled in. Individual signing the tenders or other documents connected with the contract may specify whether he signs it in the capacity of (i) a sole proprietor of the firm or constituted attorney of such sole proprietor, or (ii) a partner of the firm if it be partnership in which case he must have authority to refer to arbitration dispute

- concerning the business of the partnership whether by virtue of the partnership agreement or power of attorney or (iii) constituted attorney of the firm if it is a company.
32. If tenderer does not accept the offer, after issue of letter of award by Institute within 15 days, the offer made shall be deemed to be withdrawn without any notice.
 33. Service tax or any other tax applicable or made applicable after awarding the contract in respect of this contract shall be payable by the contractor. The Institute will not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect.
 34. Director, CMFRI reserves the right to reduce or terminate the period of contract or to extend its duration in the interest of the Institute, for any justifiable reasons, not mandatory to be communicated to the tenderer.
 35. Director/SIC, CMFRI reserves the right to reduce or increase number of workers during the contract period depending on the additional projects sanctioned or running at this centre on the same terms and conditions.
 36. Decision of Director, Institute shall be final for any aspect of the contract and binding to all parties. Disputes arising, if any on the contract will be settled at his level by mutual consultation and in case of failure of settlement dispute shall be referred to the sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Director, CMFRI. The decision of the sole Arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on the parties. Arbitration proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration & Constitution Act, 1996.
 37. Acceptance by the Institute will be communicated by FAX/letter or any other form of communication. Formal letter of acceptance and work order of the Tenders will be forwarded as soon as possible, but the earlier instructions in the FAX/letter etc should be acted upon immediately.
 38. The contract will be discontinued at the discretion of the Director, CMFRI if the work is not up to the satisfaction.
 39. Wherever and whenever it is found that the work is not up to the mark in any section an amount of Rs.500/- will be levied as liquidated damages per day. It will be brought to the notice of the supervisory staff of the firm by the Institute and if no action is taken within 24 hours liquidated damages clause will be invoked.
 40. Any misconduct/misbehavior on the part of the labours will not be tolerated and such persons will have to be replaced immediately.
 41. If the deployed numbers of workers / supervisor are less than the minimum required, a penalty of Rs.500/- per worker per day will be deducted from the bill.
 42. The decision of Director, Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute shall be final and binding on the contractor/agency in respect of any clause covered under the contract and any matter incidental to the contract.
