He/She should have UGC/CSIR/ICAR NET qualifications. OR Candidates with 3 years Bachelor's + 2 years Master's degree in the above and should have UGC/CSIR/ICAR NET qualifications and 2 years of research experience as evidenced from Fellowship/Associateship/Training/other engagements.

	For Young Professional II: Postgraduate in Marine Science/Zoology/Mariculture/Fisheries Science/ Life Sciences/Oceanography/Zoology/Marine Biology or equivalent in relevant field.
Desirable Experiences	Working experience in: Marine fishery identification; Database management systems; Those with CSIR/UGC/any fellowship will be given preference. Skill in swimming
Conditions	Candidate should be ready to work on board vessels for multiday sampling
Nature and duration of the post	Purely on contract basis for a period of one year from the date of joining or till the completion of the project whichever is earlier.
Age limit	The minimum age is 21 years, and maximum age is 45 years (with relaxation as per rules) as on the date of the interview.
Emoluments	For Senior Research Fellow: ₹37,000/- per month + HRA as applicable (for the 1st and 2nd year), ₹42,000/- per month + HRA as applicable (for the 3rd year) For Young Professional II: ₹42,000/- per month (Consolidated Emoluments as per revised ICAR guidelines)
